ANNOUNCEMENT

Technical Committee TC28: "Underground Construction in Soft Ground" of the International Society for Soil Mechanics and Geotechnical Engineering (ISSMGE) has a major commitment towards collecting information concerning tunnel design and construction in the urban environment, with regard to both bored and braced excavations.

The committee already organised six International Symposia in New Delhi (1994), London (1996), Tokyo (1999), Toulouse (2002), Amsterdam (2005), and Shanghai (2008) and decided to hold a seventh in ROMA in 2011.

THEMES

The themes for the Roma Symposium, in line with the terms of reference of Technical Committee TC28, are:

- TUNNELING IN SOFT GROUND
- DEEP EXCAVATIONS
- MONITORING
- NUMERICAL ANALYSIS
- MITIGATING MEASURES

PROGRAMME

The first two days of the Symposium will consist of technical sessions with presentations of General Reports and individual papers.

The third day will be dedicated to technical visits, amongst others to work sites of the new Linea C of Roma Underground, which will be under construction at the date of the Symposium.

For those willing to stay one more day, extra technical visits may be organised to the construction sites of Linea 1 and Linea 6 of nearby Napoli Underground.

CALL FOR PAPERS AND DEADLINES

Authors are invited to submit Abstracts of about 300 words in English, on topics relevant to one of the conference themes.

A one page Abstract with a paper title, authors' names, mailing address, e-mail address, telephone and fax number should be provided at the top of the page.

Abstracts should clearly state the purpose and conclusions of the full Papers. Both Abstracts and Papers will be reviewed by the scientific committee of Roma 2011 Symposium.

Abstracts of Papers should be sent using the Abstract Submission Form on the conference website before the 29th of February, 2010. Notification of acceptance of Abstracts will be given by the 30th of April, 2010. Camera ready manuscripts will be required by the 30th of September, 2010 for refereeing by TC28 prior to inclusion in the Symposium Pre-print volume.

The proceedings including General Reports will be published after the Symposium. The official language of the Symposium will be English.
